"Smart" Water Meter Installation

Installation will take place July 28-30

The City of Falls City received a grant from the Oregon Water Resources Department to upgrade our water meters which are nearing the end of their serviceable life span.

The new meters will allow our staff to record monthly water usage in hours versus days, with much more accurate readings.

At each individual property, the work should not last more than an hour, and before the water service is paused, installing staff will notify property owners.

Wastewater Treatment Facility Lane Closures

Wastewater Treatment Facility Construction - sewer line installation

The Falls City Highway installation of the sewer line FROM the lagoon site TO Falls City High School is ESTIMATED TO LAST INTO THE FIRST PART OF AUGUST, BASED ON PRELIMINARY GROUND BORINGS FROM THE SUB-CONTRACTOR.

THE CITY WILL KEEP THE COMMUNITY INFORMED AS THE TIMELINE PROGRESSES.

Water Line Surveying

3rd Street, Hopkins Avenue, Clark Street, Forest View Lane , and Estelle Road are being surveyed in preparation for the WATER mainline replacement project that will be occurring in the spring/summer of 2025.

The surveying is being done on the public right of way as part of the initial design of the new water service mainlines. This project is being funded by a Water Infrastructure Grant, that will cover 55% of the overall cost (\$2.4 million) to replace the most breakage prone sections of Falls City water lines (several decades old in some cases), that lead to inconvenient interruptions in water service.
